In the last year, 20 international students from 16 different countries impacted by turmoil and conflict were supported through the **Students at Risk Fund**.

The **Nasser Family Emergency Student Trust** also provides crucial support to students. More than \$66,000 in aid was distributed to students facing unexpected crises.
